

## PARAMEDICAL PROCEDURE



### Scar Camouflage

**Duration 1 DAY    Cost    £800+VAT**

Scars and skin grafts can be effectively camouflaged long-term by the implantation of carefully selected skin tone pigments to obtain a colour match that diminishes the appearance of the scar or graft.

This 1 day course has an emphasis on practical applications.

### Areola and Nipple Restoration

**Duration 1 DAY    Cost    £800 +VAT**

As part of the breast reconstruction process following mastectomy the areola and nipple complex can be restored using specialist medical micro-pigmentation techniques that create the optical illusion of a 3 dimensional complex that looks realistic.

Scarring from breast reduction (Mammoplasty) and uplift (Mastopexy) surgical procedures can also be significantly camouflaged through the implantation of custom blended pigments that disguise the scarring and treating skin diseases such as vitiligo.

This 1 day course has an emphasis on practical applications.

# Hair Replacement

**Duration: Half DAY    Cost: £500 +VAT**

Micro-pigmentation can improve the look of hair deficiency by camouflaging scars and 'shading in' bare patches of skin. Treatment sites include the camouflage of hair transplant scars, diminishing hairlines in females, the beard or moustache and the pubic region after caesarean.

Micro-hair-simulation is an innovative hair loss treatment that leaves you looking as if you have real hair. The technique creates an incredibly natural-looking simulation of micro-hairs by replicating a short hair growing from the follicle.

The effect is achieved by placing micro-points of pigment into the skin to create a shadow of colour that mimics the density of natural hair growth. The technique can be used to replace hair on the scalp, the beard, the moustache and the pubic region.

This half day course has an emphasis on practical applications

# Cleft Lip Restoration

**Duration: 1 DAY    Cost : £850+VAT**

Micro-pigmentation can improve the appearance of a cleft lip by using pigments that mimic the natural lip colour in order to recreate the cupid's bow and achieve a symmetrical shape. Scarring as a result of the reconstructive surgery associated with cleft palate surgery can also be successfully camouflaged.
